Say This:

For the Recho Mirak:

Sure, I understand, who wants to replace what is still working? But, have you considered the savings of an efficient cookstove? Our charcoal efficient stove can also save you up to 40% of your charcoal costs, saving you up to 120 HTG a month. So eventually it pays for itself AND saves you money. Wouldn't it feel good knowing saving money that you can use for your family in other ways?

Say This:

Yes, this lamp is small in size, but it provides more light than you expect. It can't light your whole house, but if you hang it in the center it can light a single room better than a kerosene lamp. Not only that, its safe and portable. If you need to walk out at night, just take it with you.

Most importantly you save money after just a few months. The average cost of kerosene for a Tet Gridap is about 5 gourds a day, with this; you stop paying for kerosene and start saving money in just three months.

Say This:

Yes, the lamp's main function is to be both a replacement for a tet gridap and also be a portable light. So it depends on which is most important to you right now, lighting or charging your phone. If it's lighting and you have another way to charge your phone, then maybe this is the right product for you. If charging your phone is really important, you probably want to consider one of our other products, which provide both.

Say This:

Well, you're in luck, we have products that do just that, our lights just look different. The Lanp Enèji Pwòp is even specifically good for this because it fits perfectly in your hand (demonstrate how to hold it as a flashlight). Not only that, once you get to wherever you are going, you can always find a hook or tree branch to hang it from and provide safety, or simply angle it up from the ground. That's actually pretty difficult to do with a traditional flashlight.
